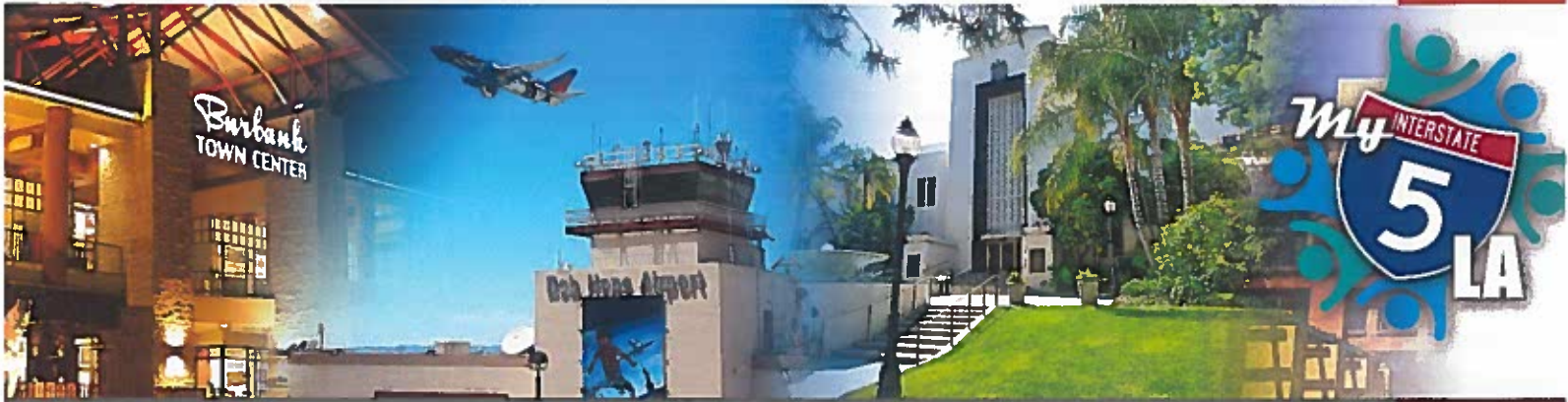
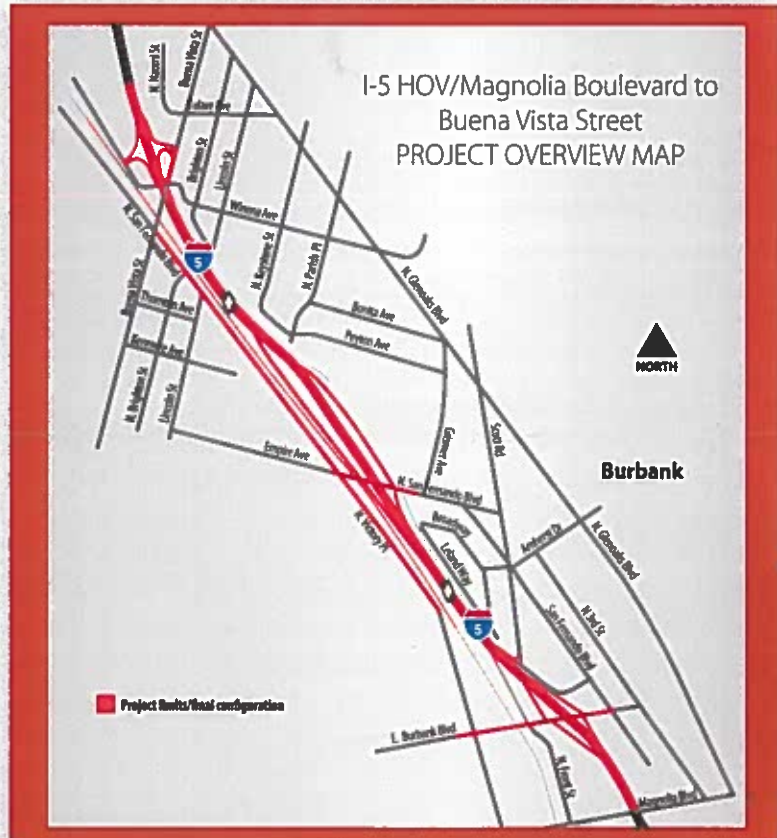


EMPIRE PROJECT | MAGNOLIA BOULEVARD TO BUENA VISTA STREET



Project Overview

The Empire Project is a series of improvements to the Golden State Freeway (I-5) in the city of Burbank between Magnolia Boulevard and Buena Vista Street. The project will improve traffic circulation on I-5 by adding 2.2 miles of carpool lanes in each direction, construct a new interchange and undercrossing at I-5 and Empire Avenue, and reconstruct the Burbank Boulevard overcrossing and realign ramps. The project will also elevate the railroad tracks near Empire Avenue and at Buena Vista Street and San Fernando Boulevard, and improve the intersection at San Fernando Boulevard, Victory Place, and Lincoln Street.
